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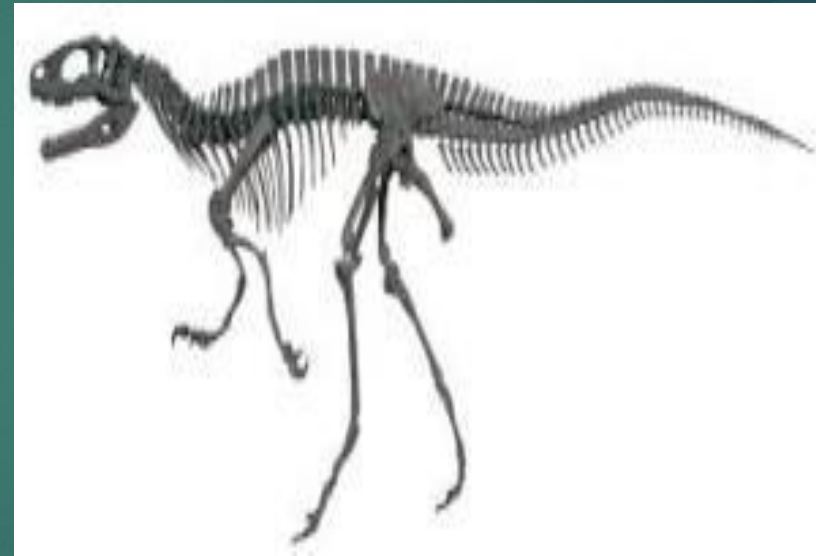

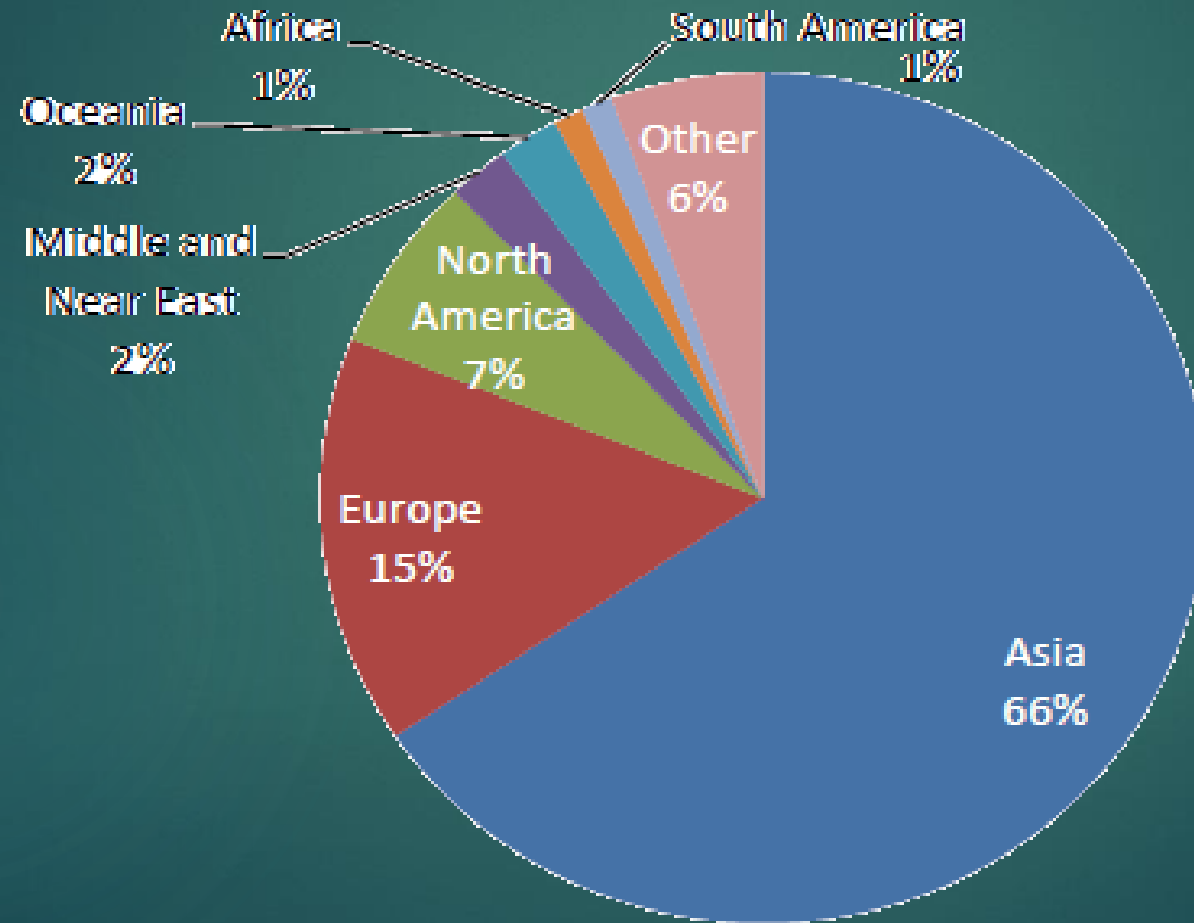

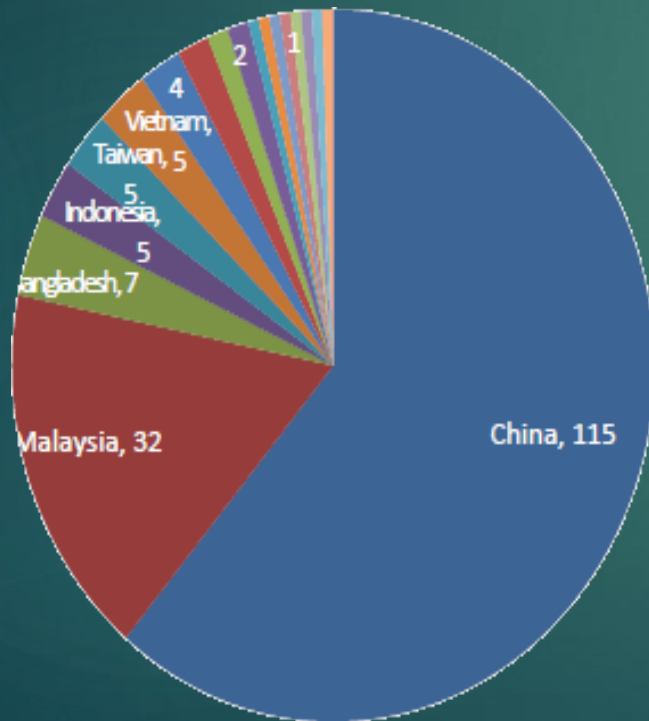

MOU : 105 universities in 30 countries and regions (2016. 09. 01)

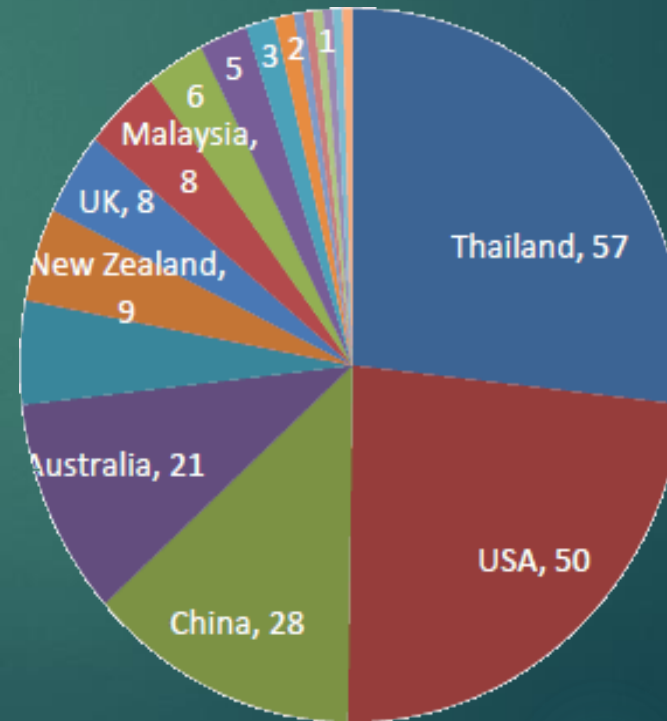


INBOUND/OUTBOUND
