USCO - DID YOU KNOW?

The USCO application platform is open to student applications for the first application cycle of the Winter/Spring 2024 competition until **August 4, 2023**. There are more than 35 semester-long exchange opportunities available in 12 countries. Some reminders:

- If you wish to nominate your students to participate in Program A/B
 semester-long exchanges, you must also offer a Program A opportunity at
 your institution. If institutions nominate students but do not offer a
 reciprocal program, those students' applications will be cancelled during
 the first placement period.
- You may nominate up to two students each semester to participate in Program A/B.

- You must complete your institutional nomination by the student application deadline of August 4.
- The second application cycle for the Winter/Spring 2024 competition will open to student applications on September 16.
