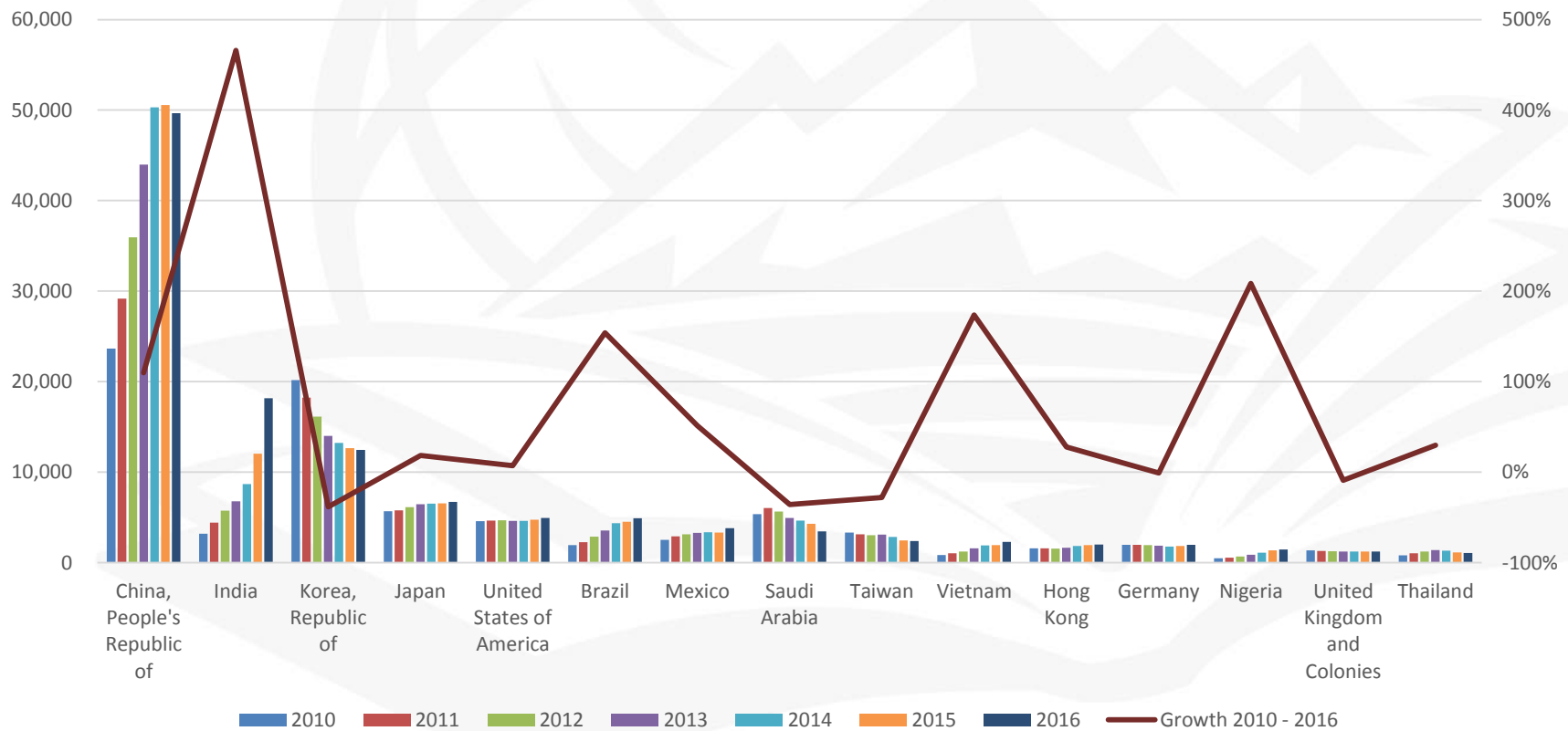

- Although 97% of Canadian universities offer international experiences, the 3.1% global education participation rate of undergraduate Canadian students is paltry
